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ABSTRACT

In the present situation, COVID-19 has left an immerse step in society leaving everyone to work and operate themselves through online "work from home". But in all these things students and teachers are the ones who are facing problems as many of the teachers who are not aware or not knowing much about technological use are lacking behind as compared to other teachers. So, it becomes the responsibility of a school to give knowledge about technology, and then they able to transact their content in the online classroom where students will also able to upgrade themselves in terms of technology. After the opening of schools and colleges, it is the responsibility of management is to equip their institution with new and advanced technologies and also not to forget to take the class through the app they are using in the current period i.e., blended learning concept as it will not them down again for making use of the learning app.

ROLE OF A TEACHER IN ONLINE CLASSROOM

✓ **TEACHING:-** In today's era, the curriculum has been transformed from traditional to modernization where all the activities carried out in the school are student-centric and so, teaching methods, techniques, curriculum, textbooks, classroom materials, and technological tools are changed accordingly. But all these things, teachers will understand when foundations of knowledge, teaching skills, pedagogy subject knowledge with practical knowledge will be given to them in an effective mode by using appropriate methods. To fill this demand, the teacher should acquire up-to-date knowledge and skills. He must prepare him before teaching a lesson. He must have the skills of introducing, explaining, asking, motivating, making reinforcement, and ending a lesson.

During this pandemic period, teachers make the use of new techniques which are available with them like jam board, whiteboard, etc with which students also share their views on that or get to know something new. Teachers assist, inspire, and encourage the learners whenever they feel so from the teacher.

✓ EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY:- As new technology is coming it is accepted by everyone in the country to make themselves developed in every area. In education, teachers should have sound knowledge of technological approaches in teaching. He should use both software and hardware approaches of educational technology for that teacher should know how to operate it. So, every teacher and learner should have knowledge of modern technology such as computers and digital devices. The

institutions have been provided different grants for providing computers, ICT, other resources and media labs, etc. So, the teacher can generate favorable attitudes towards the computer application in teaching-learning. During this pandemic period, teachers use all those methods for the teaching-learning process through PPT, videos, audio, flipped classroom, whiteboard, etc, but firstly teachers gain the knowledge by attending workshops, webinars and then implement all those things in the real classroom.

1 **EVALUATION:-** Teacher has a vital role in the evaluation process. Every progress depends on the evaluation process which enables the educational system to be reliable, valuable, and acceptable. All the systems in education follow input, process, output where the quality and quantity of output must be justified with the aims decided earlier and so that the evaluation can be done. In fact, evaluation should be done during implementation and after implementation of a project and activity conducted inside or outside the classroom. The teacher prepares a balanced question paper and evaluates the answer paper correctly without any biases. For the development of the students, teachers should follow the formative evaluation procedure and summative evaluation system. During this pandemic period, teachers evaluate the students through online mode in the form of formative and summative evaluation where students are said to disclose their videos, give authority to write or type the answers in a given area, multiple -choice questions but all these depends on the question paper design. For formative evaluation, teachers conduct the unit test, continuous assessment test, and internal assessment and for summative evaluation, the teacher conducts final examination and end-term examination.

CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT:- Teacher should have a positive role in classroom management as well as the school management. Teacher's vital role in a classroom is to teach, mentor, lead, motivate, communicate, facilitate and in assigning, etc the students in which teaching, mentoring, and assigning are the natural activities which are inside the teacher; mentoring is way a teacher encourage their students to become best they can; as a leader, the teacher should fulfill the demand of an individual, group, society, and students; motivation is an instrument which keeps learners involve in learning and helps to keep classroom quit and in control; learning and teaching in the classroom predominately take place through interpersonal communication between teachers and students. Teachers should create a classroom environment as meaningful and helpful for better learning. Students will share problems with their teacher if the classroom environment is appropriate for them.

But now teachers are managing the classroom through online mode where teachers disclose videos of themself and of the students also where the same technique is applied in the online classroom as it was during the offline classroom.

- ✓ Able to know the status of students through meeting regarding physical health

We can't just say it is the end of the teacher roles and responsibilities towards their students as we know, in the institutions, there are different levels of education making the students have different abilities to take up the things that are prevailing in today's society so, to make them aware of it and giving proper suggestions to deal with it, the teacher needs to do stimulus variations so, that students behavior can be changed according to their mental level with which they can adjust themselves in an effective way. Any conversations or activities should always consider the specific needs of children, the guidance provided by your school, local and/or national authorities, and be based on reputable sources such as UNICEF and the World Health Organization.

LEVELS OF EDUCATION

1. PRE-SCHOOL:- The teachers need to tell them by demonstrating the things by following ways-

• During games period make the students sit far away from one another by practicing stretching their arms out or flapping their wings so that they don't come closer

2. **PRIMARY SCHOOL:-** Here the students, acquire the basic knowledge and skills so, the teacher needs to be very practical while about the disease in the following ways and should involve parents also.

• Here the teachers and parents need to listen to their children/student's concerns and answer them correctly but take care of their age.

• Make them teach about how to cover the cough and sneeze with the elbow and then washing the hands for 20 seconds

• Tell them how the diseases spread when it comes into contact through demonstration

- Tell them not to go in a crowd
- Eat homemade foods

3. LOWER SECONDARY SCHOOL:- These students are in their teenage so, the teachers need to be very calm and patient while telling these things as this age child will do whatever they want but the teacher needs to collaborate with their parents so that precautions can be in control

• Whenever buying anything always sanitize the materials

• Make sure to listen to students concerns and answer their questions in a proper manner

• Emphasize that students can do a lot to keep themselves and others safe.

• Make a habit to watch the news daily regarding the disease and if any positive things come then disseminate it

• Have students make their own Public Service Announcements through school announcements and posters.

• Media literacy lessons can empower students to be critical thinkers and make them effective communicators and active citizens, which will improve their abilities to detect misinformation.

• Wear a mask and take the sanitizer wherever going outside

4. UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOL:- Again the teacher needs to tell that don't rely on the fake news; give them correct suggestion and guidance to them whenever needed; involve their parents also.

• Maintain a friendly relationship with friends, siblings, and family members

- Answer their questions honestly

• Help that person to whom you see the symptoms of coronavirus disease
